UniFirst No. 5 Chevy Makes Its Debut at Talladega on May 7

WILMINGTON, Mass., April 24, 2017 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- The No. 5 UniFirst Chevrolet SS returns to the NASCAR track for the Talladega 500 on Sunday, May 7, at 2 p.m. EDT at the Talladega Superspeedway in Alabama.
